Behaviour Policy

Dear Parents

Please ensure that your child signs and returns a copy of the Behaviour Code to their leader.

Beavers/Cubs/Scouts should be proud of who they are and act as role model for other younger members. Leaders believe good habits shown now will be continued for the rest of their lives. We expect a high standard of manners and kindness to their peers, which they too should expect to be returned.

The leaders believe that behaviour should not reach the extreme stage but there is a need to have guidelines for Beavers/Cubs/Scouts to follow. Leaders hope that parents will support us and remind boys/girls of the code. If as a parent/guardian of a Beaver/Cub/Scout you are asked to collect please support us. Only with your support can we succeed in controlling behaviour.

These are the guidelines for when the code is broken. All Scouts are familiar with this first section.

Sanctions

Beavers/Cubs/Scouts are to follow the code at all times.

If they don't:

- They will be asked to stop and reminded of the code.
- They will receive a verbal warning with what sanction will be used.
- Sanction will be enforced eg. boy/girl will not participate in activity and will be given a black spot.

If they continue:

- Parents will be asked to collect boy/girl.

If problem continues:

- Boy/girl will be excluded from 1 Pack meeting. At this stage the Group Executive and GSL are notified.

If a boy/girl's behaviour is persistent:

- Parents will be warned of a 2 week exclusion with guidelines for returning to the pack.
- A further incident and parents will be told that the boy/girl will be excluded on a permanent basis after consultation with GSL. District will be notified.

A major incident may require exclusion at any time after consultation with GSL whose decision is final.
